## **Chestermere Lake Middle School Second Chances Policy**

A summative assessment is used to determine student achievement levels for a unit of study. We know that not every day is a great day for a test, quiz, assignment and we all require a chance for a re-do from time to time. Second chances are the opportunity for students to demonstrate their learning and knowledge of key outcomes deemed pivotal for future successes. Part of our goal is to support metacognitive (students thinking about their thinking and learning) development from grades 6 – 9 for students to know what they need to demonstrate in their learning. We also want to support students as they advocate for themselves. Mistakes are part of learning and we support students in owning and learning from these.

1. For summative assessments only (those used for grades).
2. The student completes the process before the retest date.
  - a. Test signed by parent
  - b. Access teacher support or study/relearn material
  - c. Study time indicated by parent signature
3. Teacher will set the time/date for the second chance.
4. Format is at the teacher's discretion (alternate test, answer key questions, re-do sections).

Teachers determine the assessments, which cannot be re-written. This is at the teacher's discretion.
